This is who we are and without a strong and dedicated *Executive Committee*, we would not still be here with 100+ members asking, "where is the next field trip?" or "is there any more room at the next workshop?" We have a few vacant spots on the committee for this season, and in the new season ahead, we feel it will be more productive to have 2 members work together on certain positions. In that way, when the curtain goes up and the lights go down, the show, as well as the fun, will proceed smoothly.
