- 1.) Know what you want the subject of your picture to be.
- 2.) Draw the viewers eye directly to the subject by focusing all attention on the subject.
- 3.) Simplify by eliminating *anything* that takes attention away from the subject (also known as "the center of interest").

## One More Time! <u>DEFINITIONS: ASSIGNED SUBJECTS FOR 2001-2002</u>

- 1. **OLD DILAPIDATED BUILDINGS** -- Buildings in poor repair. (October 17, 2001)
- 2. **THE COLOR "RED"--**Red must be the focal point of the picture. (December 21, 2001)
- 3. **CREATIVE** -- Is defined as a departure from reality created by the use of filters, digital manipulations, reflections, montages, multiple exposures, or any technique that results in a picture that would not normally be seen with the human eye. (February 13, 2002)
- 4. **ON THE FARM** -- Anything found on a farm. (April 10, 2002)
